- Standard format and timeline for advertising events via flyers and social media
  - Board agreed that we will determine all details necessary for event promotion when we finalize events in the winter months
  - Board agreed on standard format for fliers using Canva Teri and Rory will share responsibility - Teri will send the template to Rory
  - Diane Merritt pointed out that many people don't go on Facebook and so we should make sure we have emails going out to membership to inform them of our events
    - Maybe a standard template with our logo that lists upcoming events? Teri and Destinee will work on scheduling this

  - Reviewed history of the policy of having to be a guest of a member is related to original policy that all potential new members had to be guests of an existing member and attend a few meetings before getting voted in and accepted as a member
  - The Board agreed that the following should apply to all trail rides:
    - Make sure that all trail rides have a pre-ride briefing
    - Ensure we have a sign in sheet with emergency contact information and the trail leader keeps this information on their person
    - Have any non-members sign waivers
    - Ensure everyone gets introduced to each other
    - Make sure everyone has a riding buddy
    - Ensure that the ride leader leads the ride and another volunteer is the sweep at the back of the ride IF everyone isn't going to stick together
- Discuss further in a future meeting if non-members need to be guests of members IN ADDITION to having a riding buddy
